Andrew arrived at King's in 1962, the third generation of the Hall family extending back to his grandfather, Fritz Henry Hall (OB 1883 to 1885).

His father, Frederick Vernon Mercer Hall (OB 1929), married Margaret Cox in Mudgee in 1940 following which the couple lived on the Hall family property at Girilambone, near Nyngan. Even though farming and grazing was a reserved occupation during WW2, Frederick enlisted in the Volunteer Defence Force in 1942 and made Sergeant.

By the mid-1950s the family had moved to Mangoplah, about 40km south of Wagga Wagga, where Frederick was a grazier in his own right.

At King's Andrew is remembered by his Thomas, Forrest and Harris housemates as quiet and friendly.

In the 1970s Andrew was living in Tweed Heads where he eventually became a director in a diesel fuel injection company. It seems he had married by the late 1970s.
